

# Toronto Hydro infrastructure installation on Atlantic Avenue

**Expected start date:** As early as March 25, 2024.

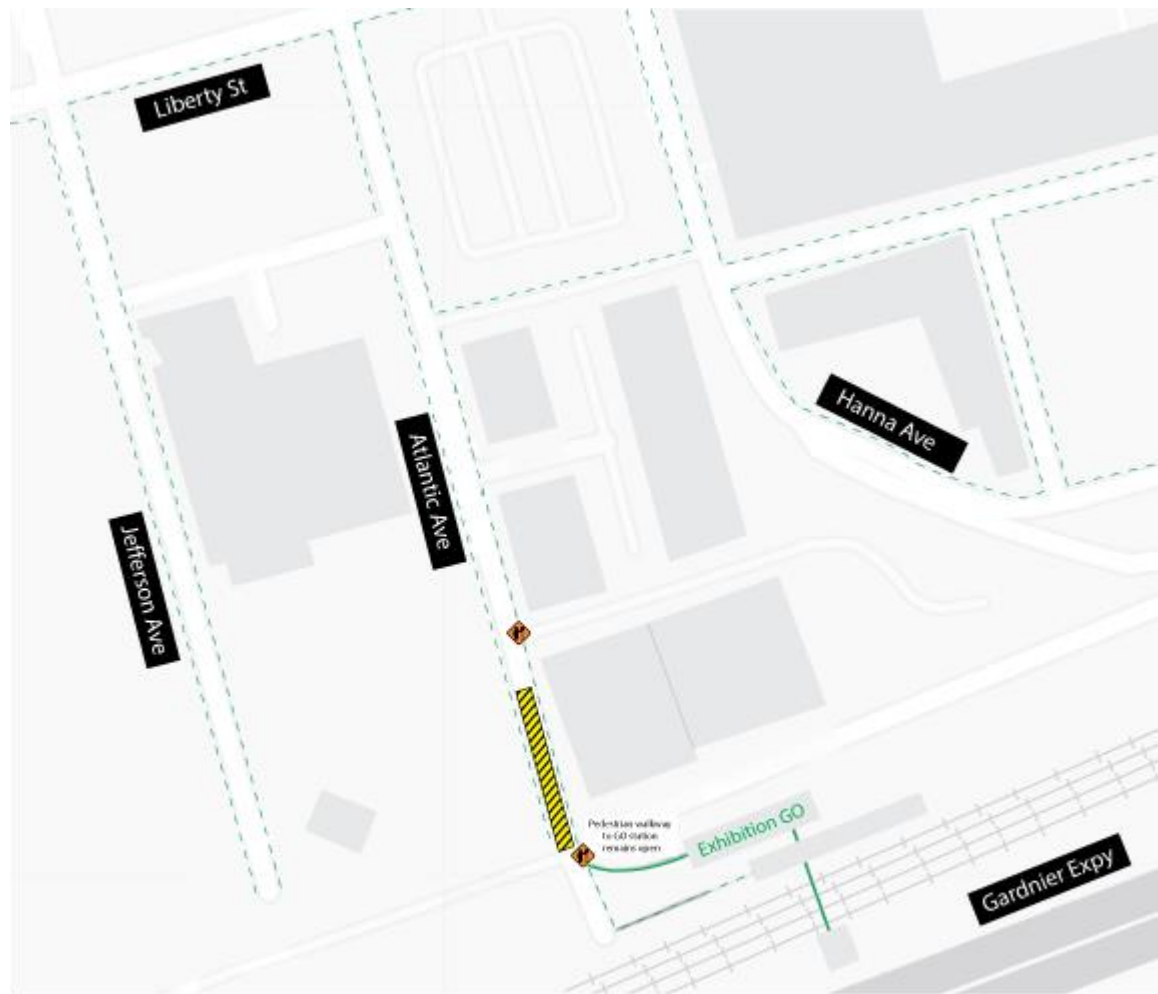
**Expected duration:** Approximately three weeks.

**Hours of work:** Daily from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

## Map of work area:

### What is happening?

- Excavation and relocation of underground utilities at the base of Atlantic Avenue, directly north of Exhibition Station.
- A portion of the roadway will be excavated, and a trench with new conduits will be built to connect and enable the new Exhibition Station.
- Once the work is complete, the roadway area will be repaved and restored.
- Equipment such as an excavator, dump trucks and grading machines will be used.

## What to expect

- The foot of Atlantic Avenue will be closed to vehicles for approximately one month.
- Full pedestrian access to the existing GO Station will be maintained on the east sidewalk of Atlantic Avenue.
- Barriers, signage, and a flag person will be used as needed to separate the closed portion of Atlantic Avenue for vehicle traffic.
- Residents and businesses can expect to see large excavators, site vans, grading equipment and dump trucks hauling dirt away from the site.
- Trucks entering and exiting site, tractor trailers with large deliveries to site.
- Liberty Village and surrounding streets will be kept clean from soil as required.
- Residents will hear noise from work equipment during work hours.
- No weekend work is expected.
- Work may be postponed or rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.
- All necessary construction permits have been obtained.
